GIVE A DAIRY GOAT

Children living in extreme poverty suffer from poor nutrition and lack basic needs because their parents can't afford required school supplies and uniforms or to take them to the doctor.

Giving a dairy goat, training, vet care and start up grasses helps lift a family out of extreme poverty. Initially the goat provides nutrition from milk, then as she has babies, she's like a bank account that keeps growing. Families can sell goats to pay school and medical expenses, build brick homes and start businesses. Manure is used to fertilize crops, doubling or tripling the harvest!

PASS IT ON!

Every family that receives a dairy goat from Food for His Children commits to passing the first born goat kid on to another family who has had training.

While a Food for His Children family is providing the goat in this case, your gift funds training, vet care and start up grasses for goat food.

Just like Giving Goat, your gift will help a family lift themselves out of poverty blessing their children with the opportunity to go to secondary school and maybe even college.

MEDICAL INSURANCE

When the poorest of the poor get sick, it can be a matter of life or death. Because their diet typically consists of only maize and porridge, their bodies struggle to fight off infection. When someone gets sick, a mother may have to choose between feeding the children who are well or using that money to take the sick child to the doctor. Having health insurance covers the medical treatment and often the medication needed, taking immense burdens off the poorest of the poor.

For just \$15, you can provide ONE YEAR of health insurance to a family of 6.

Most FFHC children have tea, porridge and a maize based meal each day. Food for His Children provides rice and beans for a special Christmas dinner to celebrate the birth of our Lord.

Your gift buys 50 kg of rice and 60 kg of beans to provide several families with an extra special meal for Christmas.



RESCUE ONE FAMILY FOR A YEAR

FFHC families are isolated and have minimal education. Having help to identify their goals and write out the steps to meet those goals is the key to getting out of poverty. Your one time gift of \$900 or \$75 per month gives regular support and encouragement; pastoral care; veterinary care; savings groups; and training in agriculture, animal husbandry, Street Business School, health and environment. AND it connects them to a community of other FFHC families. And you can write to your family and develop a personal relationship with them.

TRAIN ONE WOMAN

For people who earn less than \$1 a day, knowing how to start a new business is almost impossible. But you can send an entrepreneur to Street Business School (SBS). It's tailored for people who earn less than \$1 a day and teaches them how to start a small business and make it successful.

Berta increased her capital by 2500%! She said, "I never knew or thought that less than \$1 USD could be enough capital to start a business but Food for His Children gave me the opportunity to realize that," that insight that has changed her way of thinking about business.

KEEP GIRLS IN SCHOOL



In rural village areas of Tanzania, 65% of girls miss school every month because of their period because school bathrooms don't have water or toilet paper. FFHC families don't have money to buy sanitary products so girls use a piece of fabric instead. Missing a week school each month makes it difficult to succeed. For just \$35 you can provide 5 girls with reusable sanitary supplies keep them in school.

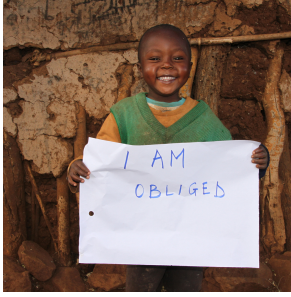


Unleashing Potential

The Food for His Children Farm and Innovation Center (FIC) will equip Tanzanian communities to overcome issues that cause extreme poverty. It's a unique combination of farming, innovation and tourism; providing sustainable income for the community development work that unleashes the potential of thousands of Tanzanians living in extreme poverty.

The FIC combines a working agricultural and dairy goat farm, training center and tourist attraction to provide real life demonstrations of innovative techniques, hands on learning and a variety of thought-provoking experiences for the community, Tanzanian students, and tourists as well as providing funding for Food for His Children's community development program.

The FIC will provide sustainable community development which transforms generations in Tanzania, unleashing the potential of thousands so that communities can thrive. The Farm and Innovation Center will also provide an opportunity to encounter Christ for tourists that may never set foot in a church, but were excited to visit a dairy goat farm in Africa. It will be a living example of what it can look like when relationships with God, self, others and creation are restored. **It will be like heaven on earth!**

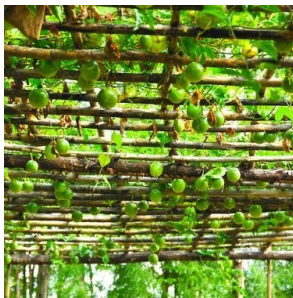

GRAPE ARBOR

Instead of wasting the space over our parking lot, we're going to grow grape vines. We can sell grapes and/or make wine to sell to tourists and local lodges as an added income stream to fund our community development work. This is also an untapped crop in the area so we will teach FFHC farmers how to amend their soil to grow grapes. Fund all or part of the Parking Lot Arbor.



RAIN WATER COLLECTION

When it rains it POURS! And why let all that rain go to waste? The FIC will teach rain water harvesting by burying SIM tanks at the base of its buildings to be used for irrigation in the dry seasons. Your gift will help purchase all or part of our rain water system. This is cheaper and safer than cement or ceramic systems that can crack with earthquakes.

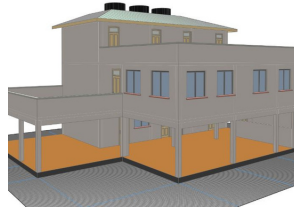

Multipurpose Ag Building

The multi-use agricultural building will house the milking parlor, creamery, and a maintenance workshop with space for farm tool storage. This building will be the anchor for the agricultural production areas and the hub of the “working” farm.



Innovation Center

\$350,000 Item #29

The three-story Innovation Center (IC) ground floor will include an internet café, gift shop, library, and training rooms. The second floor will house FFHC’s staff offices. The third floor will have volunteer housing.



SITE TREES

The FIC will have several strategically placed trees for shade and erosion control as well as beauty and food. You gift will buy a variety of trees to start our small orchards.

The caretaker home will provide a living space for the farm manager as well as their office. Since it is a working farm with livestock, it's important to have someone present 24 hours a day in case of emergencies. This building will also house 5000 liter water tanks.



GOAT SHEDS AND MILKING STATIONS

We love our goats! We're sure this will be one of the most popular items at the FIC, and one of the most popular places to hang out. For \$1800, you can build one goat shed with a sun, shade and exercise area area.
